## How are we funded?

Lightwave Red Lodge is part of a registered Charity and non-profit company (CIO) and funded entirely by grants and local donations.

For 2022-23 our four main services cost:  
£11,500 Helping Hands (food bank, advice service)  
£16,000 Community café activities  
£7,000 Youth and Children's activities  
£12,500 Christian community and worship

We are fortunate to have funding from a Church of England grant which has enabled us to start up, and will cover at least 60% of our activities until 2024. We need to raise the remaining amount through local donations and grants. West Suffolk Council have also supported us this year, so for 2022-23, we need to raise £20,000 from local giving, with more needed from 2024 onwards as our Church of England grant comes to an end.
